Ounce Of Prevention May Eliminate Pounds of Sewage

From the Westover Civic Association President



Several sanitary sewer backups occurred recently in Westover. My family experienced one several years ago, and it was not pleasant. Sanitary sewers can become clogged because of tree roots; or debris flushed down toilets and sinks becoming hung up on the jagged walls of corroding iron pipes; or parched soil "shrinking" and causing voids under sewer pipes (especially the newer plastic, PVC piping) which then break due to loss of support.

While insurance might pay for the damages caused inside your home by a sewer backup, insurance will probably not pay for the sewer line repair if required.

However, one way to potentially avoid the nastiness of such an experience is by having your home's sanitary sewer lines inspected periodically. Inspection of the sanitary sewer piping should probably occur every 3 to 7 years, or even more frequently, depending upon the age of your home and its surroundings (if you have larger trees in your front yard or abundant shrubbery in your landscaped areas).

Probably the best and most accurate method to inspect piping is by video cameras being inserted into the piping to determine the condition of the pipes and whether there are problematic areas. If only a clog or partial clog is detected, then the piping can often be immediately cleared even if the clog is caused by tree roots.

The costs for a video inspection are very modest. My plumber, Jeffrey A. Wilbur Plumbing, Heating & Plumping, Inc., charges \$440.00 and, considering that is less than my homeowner's deductible, I consider it a valuable investment. So, I encourage all of you to have your home's sanitary sewers inspected in the near future so you can protect your finished basements or items stored in your basements and do not experience the mess we did.

AND, if your gutters are clear and drainage from them is slow or non-existent, you may want to have your underground roof drains similarly inspected as well. I did and it was discovered that an oak tree's root has crushed the PVC piping which prevent any drainage from rain, snow or ice.

ELECTION DAY INFORMATION

The General Election is Tuesday, November 5, 2024 with polls in Pennsylvania open from 7:00am until 8:00pm. Westover is in the Hampden 5 (East side of Skyport Road/Hampden Diner side) and Hampden 6 (West side of Skyport Road/Wendy's side) Voting Precincts. We are represented in the 10th Congressional District, the 31st State Senate District, and the 87th State Representative District.

The in-person polling places for both precincts is located in the CV 9th Grade Academy, 451 Skyport Road, Mechanicsburg, PA 17050. The entrances are on the far right of the building accessed from the large parking area with Hampden 5 utilizing the right doors and Hampden 6 utilizing the left doors.

Whether you will vote by mail-in ballot, Absentee ballot, or in-person, should you have any questions, please contact the <u>Cumberland County Bureau of Elections</u>, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle, PA 17013, phone: 717-240-6385, with its <u>website here</u>. Don't wait until the last minute to get your questions answered or be in compliance with your registration, ballot application, or ballot return.

A: Yes! Thanks for being diligent about paying your dues. See the step by step here.


Leaf Collection


